

Walking with dinosaurs - Week 5 beginning 29.6.20

Thank you for all of the fantastic dinosaur work posted last week. We saw pictures of pasta dinosaurs, baked dinosaur biscuits and cakes plus junk model dinosaurs. They were all so individual and interesting. Well done everyone!

This week Year 2 will be continuing to focus on dinosaurs but those which were able to fly. We will post a few suggestions for activities you might like to do on Seesaw, but there are also links on the overview of activities posted previously. These will be based on what we are covering in school with the children.

Also in school we will continue to use the Oak National Academy lessons for English and Maths and we will be doing a daily spelling activity based on the spelling patterns for the week. Use the link below to access the daily lessons:

Please note that on the Oak National Academy you need to go to the **schedule** and choose **Year 2**. We are working from the current week which is **week 10 lessons starting 29th June**. If you select subjects, you get different lessons from previous weeks so please go back to the schedule.

For the Oak National Academy activities you do not require an activity sheet so please upload photographs, comments or verbal recordings of your learning via Seesaw.

If you are enjoying the BBC Bitesize daily lessons or you want more Maths or English to do, you may want to use these alongside the Oak National Academy. Remember to post your Bitesize work to us too.

We will also post some other activities including Science, Geography and RE activities which you can choose from if you wish to.

The overview of 'Walking with Dinosaur' activities was posted in the first week back and you should use this to choose activities from each week. This week's activities are colour-coded in orange and remember that any activities that are in black type can be completed at any stage throughout the topic.

Week 1 - What types of dinosaurs roamed the Earth?

Week 2 - How dinosaurs became extinct? Where do dinosaurs come on the timeline?

Week 3 - Research and present about Land Dinosaurs.

Week 4 - Research and present about Flying Dinosaurs.

*Week 5 - Research and present about Underwater Dinosaurs.

Ideas for this week include:

HISTORY/ENGLISH - Create your very own dinosaur like the scientists in 'Walking with Dinosaurs' Will your creation be a carnivore? What name will you give it? Where will it live? Will it be a predator or the prey?

ENGLISH - Write instructions for how to look after a dinosaur.
